For this exercise, you'll practice looking at your world with a different point of view than you are used to. 2. Look around at the appliances and tools that are in your kitchen. What tool or appliance would be better with some sort of change to how it works? Would your change make it faster, easier, cheaper, or have some other advantage?

At School

1. What is something your teacher must do every day that would be easier with some kind of new product or service? What could you invent to help him or her in their job?

2. Think of something that doesn't currently exist, but that the kids at your school would love to play with or use if it did. If you had a magic wand and could create it, how would this new thing change things at your school or for the world?
